7th Annual

Dayton Engineering Sciences Symposium

Abstract Deadline: Extended to October 10, 2011

Abstract submission is now open for the 7th Annual Dayton Engineering Sciences Symposium (DESS) at Wright State University. Sponsored by the ASME Dayton Section, the symposium is designed to facilitate communication between members of the regional technical community, as well as to provide a forum for students (both undergraduate & graduate), engineers, and researchers to present their work. The symposium program will include several parallel sessions in the morning and afternoon, a luncheon, an industry exhibition, and a Keynote Address. This year's symposium will feature both oral and poster presentations. Oral presentations are limited to 20 minutes including time for questions. Poster presentations should be no smaller than 20" by 30" in dimension. The ASME Dayton Section will confer "Best Presentation" awards at the annual Section Awards Banquet in late Spring, 2012.

Keynote Speaker: Mr. Joe Sciabica, Executive Director of the Air Force Research Laboratory (AFRL), will be delivering the Keynote Address on Remotely Piloted Aircraft (RPAs).

Abstract Submission: Abstracts are solicited in all areas of engineering science. Specific topic areas are expected to include: Applied Engineering; Biomechanics; Computer Engineering; Controls Science; Design & Optimization; Electronics & Sensors; Engineering Education; Fluid Mechanics; Industrial & Human Factors; Materials & Processing; Nanotechnology; Power, Propulsion, & Energy Systems; Structures & Solid Mechanics; Thermal Sciences; Engineering Innovation; and Undergraduate Design Projects. Abstracts, for both oral and poster presentations, are limited to 150 words and must be submitted online through the symposium web site:
